SMOKING

GUESTS & OTHERS

All flight tickets and/or travel insurance purchased through ESE must be paid in full immediately upon confirmation and acceptance of flights and/or travel insurance. Please see payment details below in "Payment of Fees" section below.

Step 1:

Students who are found not to be at the required B1/Intermediate level of English may have to extend their programme to achieve a 4.5 IELTS or 4depos5 in the NCC Education Standard English Placement Test at ESE at an extra cost. In such an event ESE will issue a Conditional Letter and students may opt to defer their course start date to the next for a Deferment fee of 145 euro.

ESE Attendance Policy
